a) PA/2020/692 - Notice of intention to fell a sycamore tree within conservation area at 6 St Chad, Barrow upon Humber DN19 7AU

b) PA/2020/ 621 – planning permission to erect a single storey and two storey extension at 6 Glanford Grove, Barrow upon Humber DN19 7AE

Resolved – To offer no objections

c) PA/2020/603 – Outline planning permission for residential development and associated public open space with all matters reserved for subsequent consideration – land off Ferry Road, Barrow upon Humber

Resolved: To draft a letter of objection for approval by councillors and submit accordingly.

d) PA/2020/580 – planning permission to erect a detached garage and workshop (including demolition of existing lean-to garage and shed), garden structure and single storey side and rear extension

Resolved: To offer no objections but to state that the Parish Council welcome the conditions set out by the Highways Department

e) PA/2020/775 – notice of intention to fell a fir tree and a holly tree, prune a fir tree, crown, thin and reduce two horse chestnut trees all situated with the Conservation Area

Resolved: To offer no objections if the Tree Officer approves. (NB One of these trees is damaging the church wall)

f) PA/2020/712 – application to fell a tree within G1 and with a TPO, 29 Simpson Close, Barrow upon Humber.

This application was later withdrawn

g) PA/2020/803 – planning permission to erect 9 dwellings, land north of Ferry Road, Barrow upon Humber

To submit objections similar to those relating to PA/2020/603

h) PA/2020/507 – Listed building consent for external and internal alterations, Westcote Farm, Barrow upon Humber.

Resolved: To offer no objections if the Conservation Officer approves

i) PA/2020/1145 – planning permission to partly raise the ridge line above the garage to create additional first floor accommodation at 16 Blacksmith's Close, Barrow upon Humber

Resolved: To offer no objections

j) PA/2020/903 – Planning permission to erect a stable block and detached hay barn on land adjacent to Holly Lodge, West Hann Lane, Barrow Haven

Resolved: To note that this is a retrospective planning application for work already being carried out and that Ward Cllr Hannigan has called it in to a full planning committee meeting and requested a site visit. Also to note the objections of the owner of the adjacent property.

It was agreed that the Parish Council would express their concerns at the legality of the development on relation to building regulations and at the fact that the plan had been modified, increasing the size of the operation considerably from what was originally approved.

It was further resolved that the Clerk be requested to write to North Lincs Council accordingly.
